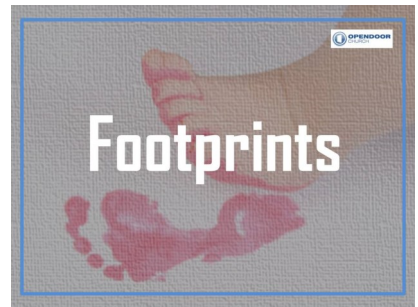
Happy New Year !

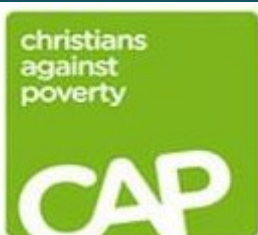

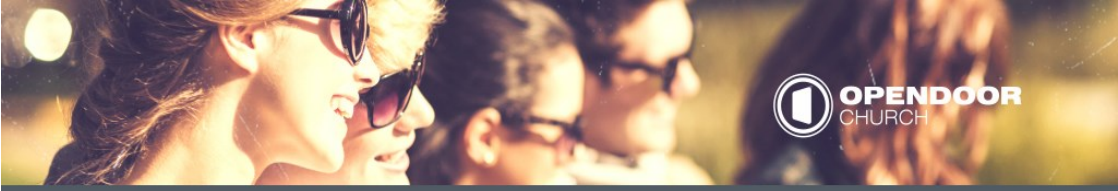
